Your monthly payment is calculated by estimating your gas use and gas prices for the next 12 months. We also take into consideration your current account balance. This total is then divided by 12 to arrive at your monthly payment amount.

From time to time we will reevaluate your Budget Plan payment. We do this to determine if your payment amount is in line with your actual




usage and future gas costs. If an adjustment is needed (either up or down), it is automatically made and will appear on your next bill statement.

Protect the ones you love with a Carbon Monoxide Detector



Carbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless, odorless and tasteless gas that is produced by the incomplete burning of various fuels, including natural gas. Those exposed to dangerous levels of CO will experience flu-like symptoms including dizziness, nausea, headache and coughing, irregular heartbeat, pale skin with cherry red lips and ear tips.

A significant contributor to CO poisoning incidents is a poorly maintained furnace. Your furnace should be cleaned and checked annually by a qualified technician to assure it is running efficiently and burning fuel properly.

The best way to prevent CO poisoning is by installing CO detectors in your home. Illinois law requires that a properly operating CO detector is installed within 15 feet of sleeping areas in all dwellings. Don't install a detector near your kitchen, garage, or in a room with a furnace, as this might trigger false alarms.

You can avoid the build up of dangerous levels of CO in your home by following these guidelines:

- Never run a combustion engine, such as the one found in your car, portable generator, lawn mower or snow blower, in enclosed areas
- Never leave a fuel-burning portable heater unattended while people sleep
- Never heat your home with your gas range or oven
- Never burn charcoal inside your home or garage
- Be sure to open your chimney flue when you use your fireplace

CO detectors come in plug-in, battery, and hardwired varieties and are available at your local hardware store. Plug-in and hard-wired models should include a battery backup and all units should be tested twice annually.
